artifacts, and was listed in the *Guinness Book of World Records* as the largest privately owned collection in the world.

## Health and Welfare

### Secrets of the Oldest Old Persons

Ever wonder how the oldest persons living today have lived their lives? How old is old anyway? Those people over 110 years are classified as supercentenarians. Verification can be challenging since records of births that long ago are often missing. The Supercentenarian Research Foundation was founded to study this age group, their siblings, and their children. Supercentenarians have now been studied for over seven years. This is what we know so far about them:

- As of May, 2008, there are 1,047 persons living.
- There are 10 persons living that are 116 years or older; the oldest is 122 years.
- Of those 115 years or older (25), all are women and a disproportionate number are African-American.
- The supercentenarians are mentally sharp, their bodies are slim but they tend to be frail. Most, but not all, are in wheelchairs but of those 115 and older, all are in wheelchairs.
- They report that they never smoked, but drank about a drink a day. The type of liquor did not make any difference.
- Of those that died during the study period, five were autopsied. Generally the cause of death was idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis —pulmonary fibrosis that develops without a known cause. It can lead to pulmonary hypertension, making the heart work harder and subsequently failing.
- Many of the oldest persons alive have relatives that are also very old.

Genetics plays an important role in the healthy aging process, but there are other factors, such as diet, exercise, and lifestyle. The researchers tell us that the supercentenarians were, for the most part, still enjoying life. Is there a lesson to learn here? ❖
