LeMay Car Collection Tour

Join the LeMay Museum staff as they guide an exclusive BMA tour of the 400 cars in the Harold LeMay collection, housed at the Marymount academy.



Harold and Nancy LeMay amassed the largest privately owned collection in the world of automobiles, motorcycles, trucks, and related

memorabilia. At its peak, the LeMay Collection numbered in excess of 3,000 vehicles and thousands of artifacts, and was listed in the *Guinness Book of World Records* as the largest privately owned collection in the world.

The LeMay Museum was chartered in 1998 to secure, preserve, and interpret the valuable LeMay Collection, along with additional vehicles and artifacts that it may acquire, in order to explore the broad themes of American mobility and lifestyle in an instructive and entertaining manner.
