## Health and Welfare

### Swine Flu

Swine Flu influenza A has spread to several countries from Mexico. It has probably come from pigs raised in farms where close contact with infected pigs has occurred. Person-to-person spread has now occurred in Washington State and the World Health Organization has raised the alert level to a level-five pandemic. The increase in reported cases each day is being followed by the CDC in Atlanta, Georgia. Travel to Mexico should be avoided in areas where the flu is prevalent, such as Mexico City. If you are traveling, learn about your destination, see a doctor before you go, and think about your health status.

Be proactive, be prepared, and be protected. Wear a mask, wash your hands, and avoid contact with persons who are ill if at all possible. See your health care provider if you develop symptoms of flu and take your temperature. Muscle aches, cough, runny nose and a temperature above 100 degrees F are important signs of impending flu.

There are antiviral medications that can reduce the virus's ability to multiply; Tamiflu and Relenza are currently being recommended. It is important to take these medications early. There is no vaccine available at this time. It may take up to 6 months to manufacture and distribute a new vaccine. The flu vaccine that was given last fall will not protect you from this new virus.
