## Food Lifeline Volunteers

### Thank You For Volunteering at Food Lifeline

A big thank you goes to the following BMA Gold Card volunteers and guests who sorted food and essentials at Food Lifeline on April 19th. Maren Bedal, Bill Droppelman, Bob Estep, Vi Johnson, Bob Keller, Bill Lee, Vicki Lee, Ed Pottenger, Mike Scott, Stan Sifferman, Marlene Taylor, Tove Thorpe, and Hans Westphal.

We set a record sorting and weighing 20,371 pounds in just two and a half hours. We really impressed the local high school students, there for their community service project, with how hard and fast we worked.

This year, the Boeing employees donated 44,000 pounds of food and essentials, the equivalent of nearly 1.2 million individual meals to ease hunger in local communities. Employees gave \$126,000 to food distributors, and matching dollars from the Employees Community Fund doubled that amount to more than a quarter of a million dollars. The food and essentials and dollars were distributed to Food Lifeline, Northwest Harvest, and Emergency Food Network.
