James (Jim) McNerney is chairman of the board, president, and chief executive officer of The Boeing Company, effective July 1, 2005. He has served as a member of the company's board since 2001.

Previously, McNerney held the position as chairman of the board and CEO of 3M, a \$20 billion global technology company. He joined 3M in 2001 after 19 years at the General Electric, where he held top executive positions including president and CEO of GE Aircraft Engines and GE Lighting; president of GE Asia-Pacific; president and CEO of GE Electrical Distribution and Control; executive vice president of GE Capital, one of the world's largest financial service companies; and president, GE Information Services.

McNerney earned a BA degree from Yale University in 1971 and an MBA from Harvard University in 1975. McNerney is married and has five children. He enjoys skiing, golf, and sailing.
